

NATIONAL STRIKE ACTION

Dear Parents / carers,

As you will be aware from the media, colleagues in NUT, NAHT, GMB, Unison, NASUWT and ATL will be taking industrial action on Wednesday 30th November.

The action (a one day strike) will result in class or whole school closures across the country.

The decision to close the school or send pupils home is never taken lightly, but in this instance, where staff have elected to take lawful industrial action, the Governors have no choice but to take appropriate steps to ensure the health, safety and well being of all pupils.

We are aware that class/school closures inconvenience parents and carers and so we are writing to give you advance notice of the likely impact of the action on this school.

The following arrangements will be in place:

School will be closed to **all** children on Wednesday 30th November for children in all classes therefore you will need to make other arrangements for the children.
