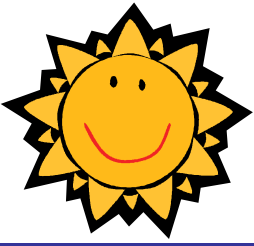


July Newsletter

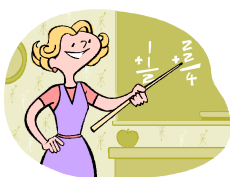
