# December Newsletter

The season of Advent is fast approaching with lots of exciting events both in and out of school. Unfortunately this term we have seen a lot of illness across the school from colds, flu, chicken pox, diarrhoea and sickness. Although illness is unavoidable please could we remind parents that in order to prevent the spread of seasonal illness we need ALL parents / carers to follow the guidance used in school from Public Health England.

The guidance for chicken pox is that the child should be kept away from school until the spots have crusted over. If suffering from diarrhoea or vomiting they should not be in school for 48 hours from last episode of sickness / diarrhoea. Children with flu should be kept off school until recovered.

Parents/carers that are unsure please call the school office for advice. Whilst we cannot force parents to keep children off school it is in everyone's interest not to spread infections.

Handwashing is pro-actively encouraged during the school day and reinforced by all school staff. This is proven to be the best method of limiting infection.

As a school we are committed to supporting good attendance but we do need parents to help us to achieve this by keeping children out of school when necessary due to illness to prevent the spread to other children and staff. We are fortunate not to have been affected to the extent of other schools locally but we do need to work together.


Children should come to school dressed in party clothes on their party day. Please just make sure they have sensible shoes and a coat for playtimes.
